
What's Happening:

- CN freight trains pass through the rail crossing at speeds up to 45 mph, where their tracks intersect Metra's Union Pacific Northwest Line.
- This creates extreme ground vibration, causing:
 - Cracked foundations and porches
 - Shaking beds and cabinets
 - Structural damage to homes and businesses
- Beyond the visible cracks in walls or damaged foundations, there is a deep emotional toll on residents' health and well-being.
- Residents are being forced to leave due to unbearable living conditions.



What We're Demanding:

- The Federal Railroad Administration (RFA) to reduce CN trains' maximum speed limit to 25 miles per hour (mph).
- Stop further properties' deterioration.
- Seek fair compensation for damage already occurred.
- Action from CN, FRA, and elected officials.
